Re: Student Email Accounts

To better manage available data storage and save money on licensing costs, a change is being implemented in how student email accounts are handled. Currently, once a student email account is created the account is never deleted, even if the student is no longer enrolled at Prairie View. As a result, the data storage requirements and licensing costs are increasing dramatically for email accounts that are never used.

Effective immediately, email accounts for students who do not return for two long semesters will be deleted. The deletion will occur at the end of the second long semester of non-attendance or until approximately mid-way through the semester so late registrants are not inadvertently deleted. If a student subsequently returns, the account will be reestablished, but email from previous periods will no longer be available.

Please note that this change will not affect currently enrolled students, only those students who have not enrolled for two long semesters.
