Re: Harris County Public Health and Environmental Services Free H1N1 Clinic

The holidays are a joyful time when families and friends gather to share meals and exchange warm wishes and gifts. Now, let's prevent families from having more than fun and fond memories.

In an effort to reduce the potential of catching and spreading the H1N1 virus, the Harris County Public Health and Environmental Services in partnership with Cy-Fair Independent School District have setup a free H1N1 vaccination clinic open to the public for persons of all ages and health status.

The clinic will be held on Saturday, December 12, 2009 from 8:30a.m. – 2:00p.m at the Berry Center located at 8877 Barker Cypress Road, Cypress, Texas. You will not need to bring anything with you.

Get vaccinated to prevent the spread of the flu virus. You could infect others with the flu as early as one (1) day before symptoms develop and up to 5-7 days after becoming sick. This means that you may be able to pass the flue to someone else even before you realize that you are sick.

The flu shot is the best prescription to protect your loved ones from the flu! Remember, the flu season does not end until May. Get your flu shot for a health holiday season.
