Registration Information

The registration fee for the Career Fair is **\$500.00** per booth for corporate, **\$350.00** per booth for government agencies and not-for-profit organizations, **\$150.00** per booth for educational institutions. Fees include one 8'x10' booth with a draped table, two chairs, and a large header sign bearing the organization's name.

Oversized booths are limited and available on a first come basis. Cost is an additional \$250.00 per booth.
