DIRECTIONS: Materials to be submitted for the study-abroad program must be typed. Program directors will not accept faxed application nor handwritten application items. Applicants must submit their completed applications as a single package --- unofficial/unsealed transcripts or unsealed letters of recommendations will invalidate the application.

A. APPLICATION FORM Prairie View A&M University's study abroad program is a competitive process that is open to students who are in their sophomore, junior, senior, and graduate years. B. PERSONAL ESSAY Applicants are required to compose a personal essay of no more than three typed, double-spaced pages. The essay should describe

- 1) Your interest in and/or commitment to a international service career;
- 2) The ways that your participation in the PVAMU study abroad program will help you achieve your goals; and
- 3) What you hope to gain from your participation in this year's study abroad program

C. BUDGET

Please detail the costs for the desired program.
(Detailed budget may be attached as addendum on separate sheet)

D. RESUME

Submit a resume that details
(a) your work experience,
(b) your achievements/awards, and
(c) your organizational affiliation

E. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

- Submit
- (a) two (2) letters of recommendation from *faculty members, dean or advisor* at your college, and
 - (b) one (1) letter of personal recommendation from someone who can speak of your character.

F. OFFICIAL COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS

Provide official sealed transcripts from all colleges and universities you have attended.

G. POST-TRAVEL REPORT

Students are expected to submit a post-travel report as specified by the Center for International Studies and Research.
