4. Select two courses (8 hrs) of science in Biology, Chemistry, Geology or Physics. Eight hrs of sequential courses in these areas are also acceptable.
5. Select any 3 hrs from ARTS 1303, 1304; DRAM 1310, 2361, 2362; MUSC 1301, 1306
6. Select any 3 hrs from ARTS 1303, 1304; DRAM 1310, 2361, 2362; MUSI 1306; FREN 2311, 2312; SPAN 2311, 2312
7. Course not required in the LSC curriculum; may be transferred to PVAMU subject to a max of 72 hours.
