We are currently accepting Student Teaching Applications for the Spring 2011 semester. Students are eligible for admission to student teaching after the following requirements have been met:

- Completion of the respective EC-6, EC-12, 4-8, or 8-12 major requirements with a minimum 2.50 grade point average. Only grades of C or above will be accepted. *(Degree Audit's signed by your advisor, verifying the completion of all course work will be required for processing).*
- Completion of the professional development requirements with a minimum 2.50 grade point average. Only grades of C or above will be accepted. *(Degree Audit's signed by your advisor, verifying the completion of all course work will be required for processing).*
- Verification that the candidate has successfully passed a criminal background check.
- Documentation that representative TExES content and pedagogy licensure examinations have been taken.
