



Nuclear Regulatory Commission Grant Scholarship Opportunities

Roy G. Perry College of Engineering Prairie View A&M University

Scholarships are available for students majoring in any of the Engineering or science majors who have interest in the energy engineering particularly nuclear energy and engineering. Individuals in good academic standing (GPA 3.0 or more) and interested in careers in the nuclear energy area are encouraged to apply. These scholarships are awarded for one academic year and may be renewed annually based on meeting the conditions of the scholarship. The amount of scholarship will be a minimum of \$5000 per year (\$2500/semester). The scholarship recipients must sign a service agreement which requires them to work in the nuclear area for six months for every one year of scholarship.

Scholarships are made available from a US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Scholarship Grant awarded to the Departments of Civil and Environmental Engineering and College of Engineering. Please contact Dr. Kommalapati (x1660) for more information.

Purpose of the Scholarship

These scholarships are aimed at recruiting and preparing underrepresented groups for careers in the nuclear industry

Eligibility

To be eligible for the scholarship the students must meet the following minimum criteria:

- Student must have a GPA of 3.00 or higher
- Sophomore, Junior and Senior in your respective majors. Transfer students will be considered as well
- Students must be US citizens or permanent residents
- Must submit an essay describing their career goals and how those goals are related to NRC and if awarded how this scholarship can help them with those goals. Recipients must sign a service agreement which requires them to maintain the GPA and work in the nuclear energy field for six months for every year of support they receive from this grant. If you do not meet this requirement, the recipient could be obligated to repay the NRC the full amount of the scholarship.

Conditions

- Students must be full-time during the period the scholarship is awarded and maintain satisfactory academic progress (i.e. maintain 3.0 GPA)
- Students must disclose all financial assistance received from the university and other agencies.
- Students must work with a PVAMU Faculty Advisor(s)
- Students must participate in at least 1 summer internships with NRC and/or other agencies related to nuclear field and submit a written report.
- Must attend all seminars, fieldtrips and other meetings organized by the Project Team. Additionally, students will be asked to present their research and/or experiences at selected seminars/workshops.
- Must complete the Elective courses offered as part of this program.
- Must participate in the E-mentoring program to work with professionals from nuclear industry.
- Must submit a comprehensive annual report on their activities including the summer internship.

Interested Students Should Submit the Following

- Application Unofficial Transcripts
- Two Letters of Recommendation Graduation Plan
- A one-page, typed, single-spaced essay describing the career goals, how these goals match with NRC scholarship requirements and how this scholarship can help you in achieving these goals.
