Before taking the CUIN courses, candidates are required to:

Task

1. complete the University core
2. complete, with an advisor an application for admission into teacher education
3. have a GPA in the University core of 2.5 or higher
4. have no grade below C in ENGL1123, ENGL1133, MATH1113;
5. have a THEA score of 230 or higher in Reading; and
6. have University passing THEA scores in Math and Writing

Students should make use of the Educator Preparation, Counseling and Diagnostic (Testing) Laboratory in Delco to prepare for the two required state exams: 1) Pedagogy and Professional Responsibilities (PPR 8-12), #130, and 2) ELAR 8-12, #131. Students seeking certification should familiarize themselves with the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) manuals and materials in the subject area(s) and also the requirements for the PPR.

The English Program requires the senior-level **Special Topics in English** capstone course so that you will "demonstrate capacity to bring information, skills, and ideas acquired from the English major and various curricula to bear on a major project." The course is designed to provide you with an opportunity to synthesize your growing understanding of language, literature, and composition and to move beyond the content of such courses to an understanding of the theoretic assumptions underlying that content. Keep your written work over the semesters to make compiling this portfolio easy when the time comes. This portfolio will be used to help the English Program assess its own strengths and weaknesses. Because this is an ePortfolio, you will have access to it for job-market interviews or graduate school.
