A quick guide to PVPlace.

Setup Your Online Reset Account

The university offers an online reset tool for PantherNet accounts. Users that enroll in the tool are able to reset their password as long as they have access to the internet. Rather than calling IT Helpdesk or having to drive to campus to have an account reset, the tool is conveniently available online 24 hours a day.

Enrollment is the Key

A link to the password reset tool is conveniently located in the Featured Links channel of the Home tab within PVPlace. It is recommended that you enroll at least once initially and subsequently re-enroll to update your information if you find that you have had trouble remembering your questions and answers.
