Once again, it is with great pleasure and pride that I inform you of the availability of **AAM Volume 15**, **Issue 2 (December 2020)** of *Applications and Applied Mathematics: An International Journal* (AAM) at the end of its 15<sup>th</sup> year of existence. This volume, with attached Table of Contents contains **43 papers and 776 pages.** With this issue, we end the year with a **total of 81 articles and a total of 1448 pages** of quality papers, peer-reviewed and in all mathematical sciences, statistics, operations research, physics and engineering. The next regular issue will appear in the AAM's 16<sup>th</sup> year in June of 2021.

Manuscripts with rates higher than 25% of duplications are being rejected. Thus, with this task and pre-review of manuscripts, a high percentage of arriving manuscripts are rejected before going to full review. This will enhance the processing times of the AAM staff and reviewers.
