3. Must be in good standing with the university.
4. Complete the application (by **September 22, 2016 by 5pm**) and successfully participate in any interview process.

Expectations of PhD Members

1. Successful candidates will be required to sign a Confidentiality and Commitment Agreement that cover the confidentiality statement, the attendance requirements and ethical guidelines for Panther PhD members.
2. Complete the Certified Peer Education (CPE) Training program; attend meetings, scheduled presentation and annual training.
