Investigation revealed that local chapters existed at three schools. Those three schools along with a few other schools formed a National Honor Society Committee in November 1960. For more than a year this committee worked on the constitution and other administrative matters. The name Phi Alpha and the key were adopted from the local chapter which existed at Florida State University. The constitution and formal organization were completed in 1962, and six chapters quailed to be "charter chapters".

The six charter chapters were Florida State, Michigan State University, Central State College, University of Dayton and University of Tennessee. Over 110 chapters are now in existence, and the addition of new chapters is continuing.
