
## **Deloitte Foundation**

- Strong academic track record; minimum of 3.0 GPA (on 4.0 scale)
- Must be a US citizen or permanent resident
- Must meet the standards for admission into a Deloitte Foundation selected AACSB accredited college/ university master's program in accounting
- Have an interest in pursuing a career in public accounting and obtaining their CPA, but not presently a
  CPA
- Selected participants must matriculate to the University's master's of accounting program for the duration of the academic school year and be eligible to complete such program by May 2024.
