
# CERTIFICATE IN INNOVATION & ENTREPRENEURSHIP

The three (3) course certificate will provide students with functional knowledge and skills in business that are required for a broad understanding of the field of entrepreneurship and help students learn to identify, conceptualize, plan, finance, launch, manage and reap the rewards of a new venture. Both non-business and business majors are eligible for the certificate.
