## Women in Agriculture Conference Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

**QUESTION:** When is the Women in Agriculture Conference?

**ANSWER:** The Women in Agriculture Conference will be held **Thursday, February 23, 2023**, beginning with onsite registration at 7:30-8:30 a.m., welcome from 8:30 a.m.-9:00 a.m., and adjourning at 4 p.m. There will also be an optional farm tour at 4 p.m.

**QUESTION:** Will the conference be held in person?

**ANSWER:** The Women in Agriculture Conference will be held in person/face-to-face.

**QUESTION:** Is there a registration fee for the Women in Agriculture Conference?

**ANSWER:** There is no charge to register for the conference. The Women in Agriculture Conference is free, though for planning purposes registration is required.

**QUESTION:** When is the deadline for registration?

**ANSWER:** The deadline for registration online is February 17<sup>th</sup>. Seats are limited.

Limited onsite registration will also be available the day of the conference on February 23<sup>rd</sup> from 7:30-8:30 a.m.

**QUESTION:** Will I need a parking pass to attend the conference?

**ANSWER:** Parking passes are required and parking instructions will be provided via email prior to the conference

**QUESTION:** Will lunch be provided?

**ANSWER:** Yes, lunch will be provided for each registered attendee. Allergy restrictions and meal preferences (vegetarian, vegan, no beef, no pork, etc.) can be provided during registration.

**QUESTION:** What is the attire for the conference?

**ANSWER:** The attire will be casual or business casual. Attendees may consider wearing farm-friendly shoes/clothing should they wish to tour the campus farm (optional).

**QUESTION:** What methods of payments can be used to pay for sponsorships?

**ANSWER:** Sponsorships can be paid by check or money order, payable to Prairie View A&M University (PVAMU) Cooperative Extension Program (CEP) (AgNR).

**QUESTION:** What amenities are available with a paid sponsorship?

**ANSWER:** The six sponsorship levels and the corresponding amenities for each are as follows:

**Patron Two** (\$100-\$399), 1 - advertisement space in the conference program;

**Patron One** (\$400-\$999), 1 - Conference registration 1 - Booth with table and skirt 1- Advertisement space in the conference program Free access to internet;

**Bronze** (\$1,000-\$4,999), 2 - Conference registrations 1 - Booth with table and skirt 1 - advertisement space in the conference program Free access to internet;

**Silver** (\$5,000-\$14,999), 2 - Conference registrations 1 - Booth with table and skirt 1 - advertisement space in the conference program Free access to internet;

**Gold** (\$15,000-\$24,999), 3 - Conference registrations 2 - Booth with table and skirt 1 - advertisement space in the conference program Free access to internet; and

**Platinum** (\$25,000+), 3 - Conference registrations 2 - Booths with tables and skirts 2 - advertisement space in the conference program Free access to internet. See committee for details on sponsorships and to complete and submit a Sponsorship Form.

**QUESTION:** **When is the deadline to submit the Sponsorship Form with payment?**
