Energy research at CEES entails fossil fuels, alternate energy sources such as bioenergy, wind energy, and environmental sustainability. This field of study has tremendous potential and high demand for graduates. CEES is very excited to offer scholarships for those that want to pursue Energy Research.

Requirements:

- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident of the U.S.
- Must be an undergraduate student in engineering, science or agriculture
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Must submit CEES scholarship packet
- Must include an essay describing your interest in specific energy topic and how this experience will help to meet your career goals
- Must commit to conduct research for the required number of hours (10-20 hrs per week) depending on the awarded scholarship)

Awards: \$2500 for the academic year. The scholarships are awarded to the student at the beginning of the semester once they have selected their research topic, identified their advisor to work with and commit to required number of hours per week. NOTE: All awards are contingent upon the availability of funds and are subject to change.
