- Engage with local businesses and universities
- Meet up with young elite entrepreneurs
- Engage with youth from SOS Children's Village
- Learn about circular economy and emotional intelligence
- Spend a day on safari, spotting lions, elephants, hippos, zebras, etc.
- Experience local art, music and customs
- Spend time with diverse young people from Tanzania and Zanzibar

The YGP learning architecture has been developed by Professor Rangan from INSEAD Business School, and the learning JOURNEYS have been designed in partnership with companies, universities, SOS Children's Village, Save the Children, WWF and other affiliate organizations.

## WHO CAN APPLY? (AND WHAT IS INCLUDED)

Young Global Pioneers connects young talents, who are ambitious and curious to find out how they can make their mark as the next-generation of responsible global leaders. To YGP, leadership and talent are also about striving to make a difference, and having the ambition to make it happen.

To be eligible for the Accenture Scholarship you must meet the following criteria:

- Be 19-25 years old
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.2
- Be currently pursuing a degree from an accredited institution with a graduation date of no later than December 2020, All majors considered

In Tanzania all activities, meals, domestic flights, accommodation and local guides are included in the scholarship. Additionally, the scholarship will cover international flight tickets, insurances, vaccinations, and visa.

## HOW TO APPLY?

The deadline for applying is March 5<sup>th</sup> 2017. Applicants will hear back from YGP no later than March 14<sup>th</sup> and the final selection will be announced early April 2017.
