



## Prairie View A&M University Whitlowe R. Green College of Education

### Scholarship Criteria

All Whitlowe R. Green College of Education Scholarships will be awarded and funded based on and subject to the following criteria: (a) availability of funds (some scholarships have limited funding available based on the percent accrued in the endowment or amount remaining in the fund balance); (b) adherence to the scholarship guidelines established by the donor(s); (c) submission of all required applications materials, (d) completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with final approval from PVAMU Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships, (e) merit and/or need of the recipient, and (f) adherence to the university guidelines for enrollment and conduct. Incomplete submissions are ineligible for funding consideration. Applicants may list up to a total of three scholarships on the online application, but funding is subject to the specifications referenced in the scholarship guidelines.

#### Undergraduate Student Scholarships

##### **Butler Family Endowed Memorial Scholarship**

Major: Education.

The applicant must be a U.S. Citizen, high school graduate and accepted for enrollment as a full time student (minimum 12 semester hours) at PVAMU. The applicant must not have any juvenile or criminal convictions. Once the student has been admitted, he/she must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.50 to continue as a scholarship recipient and must maintain acceptable behavior and conduct. Inappropriate conduct, as defined by the University Code of Conduct, may result in scholarship termination.

The applications packet should include the following items.

- 1) A letter, statement, or tuition receipt from the university verifying that the applicant is accepted for enrollment as an undergraduate student on a full-time basis.
- 2) A composition of 300 words or less to include: (a) the reason for attending Prairie View A&M University, (b) significant high school and/or community accomplishments and (c) plans for participation in student or extra curricula activities.
- 3) Three letters of recommendation from any one of the following persons: (a) high school administrator (Principal, counselor, teacher); (b) College professor/faculty member; and (c) community leader (pastor, civic leader, etc.).

#### **Caesar A. & Estella Dial Endowed Scholarship**

Major: Agriculture or Education. All undergraduate classifications.

The applicant must hold a 2.50 cumulative GPA. The scholarship is for students with a need-based reason for seeking financial assistance (lack of financial resources) and from a low income family. The total dollar amount of the scholarship is \$3000. The total dollar amount that each student may receive each semester is \$1500. The total dollar amount of scholarship award that may be offered for scholarship recipients each semester is \$1500.

#### **A. J. Jones Graduate Nursing Scholarship**

Major: Education or Nursing. Must be a Texas Resident.

The applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 3.00. The applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from nursing or education faculty.

#### **Aquila Mcgrew, Jr. Endowed Scholarship**

Major: Education. All classifications.

Preference should be given to students majoring in elementary school education. The applicant must have a 2.50 cumulative GPA. The total dollar amount that each student may receive each semester is \$500. The scholarship should be awarded to students with a need-based reason for seeking financial assistance (lack of financial resources) and from a low income family.

#### **Addie Sarah Mcgrew Endowed Scholarship**

Major: Education. All classifications.

Preference should be given to students majoring in Elementary School Education. The applicant must have a 2.50 cumulative GPA. The applicant must have a major GPA of 2.50. The scholarship should be awarded to students with a need-based reason for seeking financial assistance (lack of financial resources) and from a low income family. The total dollar amount that each student may receive each semester is \$500.

#### **George Meador Endowed Scholarship (Availability of Funding Date is Pending)**

Major: Education. Undergraduates Only. The applicant must be a full-time student with a minimum major GPA of 2.50, minor GPA of 2.50 or high school GPA of 2.5. Additionally, the

applicant must be involved in extracurricular activities and have a financial need. The total dollar amount that each student may receive each semester is \$1200.

### **M. Paul Mehta Endowment Scholarship**

Major: Interdisciplinary studies. Undergraduate junior or senior.

The applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00. The scholarship is based totally on merit and is awarded a maximum of one scholarship per semester for \$1000.

### **Kimberly René Scott Endowed Scholarship for Education Majors**

Major: Education. Juniors and Seniors.

The applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher with a semester GPA of 2.50 or higher and should be enrolled in a minimum of 12 hours during the semester of the receipt of the scholarship. The recipient must meet the requirements and is awarded one scholarship for the designated semester for a total of \$1000.

### **James & Patricia Solomon Scholarship**

Major: Education.

The scholarship is for student from the Detroit, MI area. The applicant must have a minimum 2.50 GPA in the major; a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 and a minimum high school GPA of 3.50 with SAT scores of 1200 and above or ACT scores of 23 and above.

### **National Prairie View Alumni Teacher Education Scholarship Fund**

Major: Education.

The scholarship recipient will be selected based on both merit and financial need. The applicant must have a 2.5 GPA and must be in the top 25% of his or her high school graduating class. The applicant must be currently enrolled fulltime (12 hours; 6 hours, if student teaching) and a current student.

### **Rebecca E. Wright Endowed Scholarship**

Major: Nursing or Education

The applicant must be a Texas resident and have a 3.00 cumulative GPA or higher and must have at least 60 hours completed. The applicant must be active in an extra-curricular activity.

### **Texas Quality Enhancement Endowed Scholarship**

Major: Education. Undergraduate student.

The applicant must pursue a teaching certificate and be willing to teach in a "high need" area; (e.g., school in which 50% or more of the enrolled students are eligible for reduce lunch).
