two articles (artifacts) that discuss fundamentals of leadership. & amp;nbsp; After reading the articles students are required to critique the article. & amp;nbsp; The article should contain a Synopsis, Critique (which should include the Domain and Competency) and Implications. & amp;nbsp;& amp;nbsp;& amp;nbsp; The purpose of reviewing an article is to ensure that students can understand the vision of learning, define the culture of teaching and learning, explain the relationship with the broader community to foster learning.
