

Developing Conceptual Framework and Research Questions

Course Description: This course examines advancedcompetencies to conceptualize, design, analyze, report and publish quantitative research that delivers new and useful knowledge.

Class Presentation: Identify an educational phenomenon that needs to be researched. Give the subject a title, develop a problem statement, hypotheses (at least 4), and a rationale for the study using at least 5 references from primary sources. Include a description of the population and sample. Provide a 1 or 2 page outline for class members
