Admission to Clinical Experiences (Formerly Student Teaching)***

- Effective for Spring 2015 applications, all students must have passed the state certification content exam <u>prior</u> to admission into <u>Clinical Experiences</u>.

- Students must submit the complete clinical experiences packet to the Office of Clinical Experiences and have a GPA of ≥ 2.75

- 3. Complete Student Teaching.
