TX Grant Renewal Awards

At the end of the **initial year**, a student entering the program must be meeting the school's Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements.

At the end of the **second year** in the program or later years, all students:

- Must have an overall college grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Must complete at least 24 semester credit hours per year.
