An F-1 Student may be enrolled in two different approved schools at one time as long as:

1. Combined enrollment is equivalent to a full course of study
2. The student is enrolled in a degree program at one of the two schools
3. Attendance at the other school is with permission of a designated school official at the school where the student is enrolled in a degree program
4. The coursework at the other school will be accepted for fulfilling degree requirements
5. A designated school official at the school where the student is enrolled in a degree program has evidence that student's enrollment is the equivalent of a full course of study
6. The official who issues the Form I-20 is in all respects responsible for all regulatory record-keeping and reporting requirements relating to the student.
