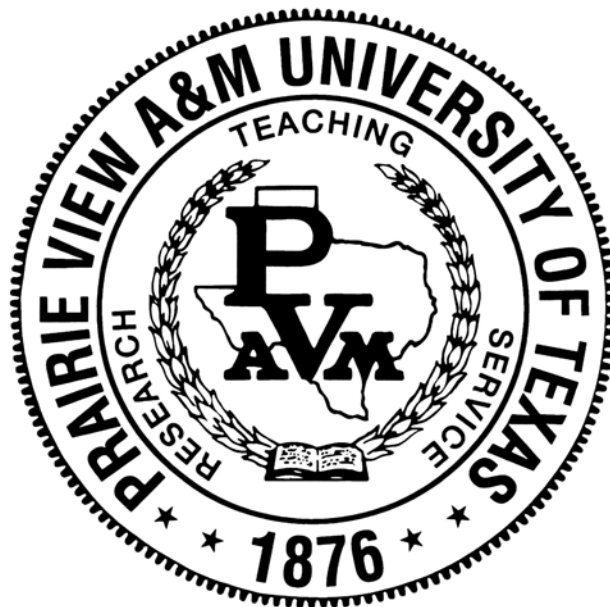


Provisions of this Catalog
