### Time Limit on Work for Doctoral Degree and Revalidation of Courses

A student must complete the requirements for the doctorate degree within nine consecutive years after the first date of enrollment in Graduate School.

Each department will have documentation in the doctoral student's file of a signed acknowledgment by the student that credits older than a specific number of years will be considered expired. In some programs, this will be less than nine years, for example, the DBA credits expire in six years. Thus, a doctoral degree must be completed within nine years.

Each student's file in their academic department will have a signed document by the student regarding credit expiration.
