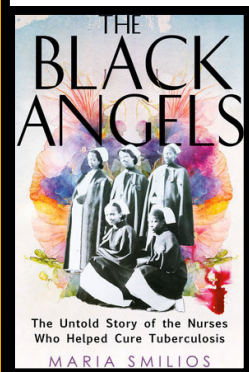

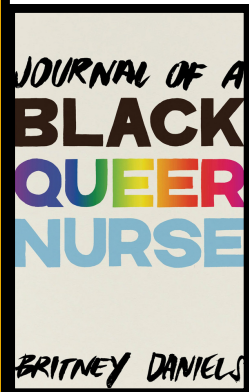

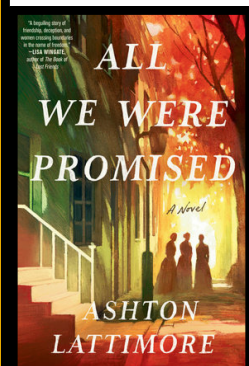

Can I access articles written by nurses?

Yes! CINAHL is the most popular database that allows you to limit your search specifically to sources written by nurses. To do this, you'd perform an advanced search and check the "Author is Nurse" box. Contact me for a tutorial!

What are LibGuides?

LibGuides or library guides are pages organized by librarians to share information with patrons. Course guides are created to share information pertaining to a specific course. These guides are tailored to specified courses.

How do I check out a book at the TMC Library?

If you are registered with the TMC Library, take your PVAMU ID and the items you would like to check out to the circulation desk. If you are not registered, but interested in applying, please email Mrs. Walker.

Do you have a physical copy of the Publication of the American Psychological Association (APA)?

Yes! This is a reference book. You may check this title out for CON use only. Stop by Room 941 if you're interested in using the manual.

How do I request an interlibrary loan?

If you need materials that are not currently available, you may fill out an interlibrary loan request form. When filling out the form, ensure you include as much publication information as possible about the source. For instance, noting volume and issue numbers for journal articles.

Can you show me how to add my sources to RefWorks?

Absolutely! Please contact me for a consultation via Zoom, phone, or in-person.
