**Abstract:** Black Churches in Texas Collection contains the manuscripts of the book "Black Churches in Texas" by Clyde McQueen, as well as proof samples for the book cover, spine, and image plates. The collection also includes the maps used to delineate the regions studied in the book, a headshot of author Clyde McQueen, and correspondence between McQueen, Tammy Henry (Texas A&M Publications), and Frank Bruno (Prairie View A&M University's former Director of Libraries).

**Biographical Note:** In *Black Churches in Texas*, author Clyde McQueen catalogs 374 black congregations, each at least one hundred years old, in the parts of Texas where most blacks were likely to have settled—east of Interstate Highway 35 and from the Red River to the Gulf of Mexico. Ninety-nine counties are divided into five regions: Central Texas, East Texas, the Gulf Coast, North Texas, and South Texas. For each congregation, McQueen provides the year it was organized, the county and town where it is located, and an address or directions for finding it; any other history, lore, or facts available are also given. Information was gathered from interviews, church bulletins, special church programs, historical markers, and building cornerstones.

Clyde McQueen was born in Lily Island, Texas, on August 24, 1926, and passed away on May 13, 2020 in Temple, Texas. Mr. McQueen paused his high-school education to join the Navy, where he served as an apprentice seaman during WWII (1944-1946) and during the

Korean War (1951-1952), earning a Combat Infantry Badge and battle star. After his discharge from the Navy, he finished his high school education and then attended Prairie View A&M University (then Prairie View College), earning an Undergraduate and Master of Science in Education in 1957. He completed a Master of Urban Planning from Texas A&M University in 1970. From 1965 to 1972, he worked as a Soil Conservationist for the U.S.D.A. in Brazos, Burleson, and Waller counties, finishing his career in Tyler, Texas. McQueen retired on July 3, 1984, after 31 years of service to the federal government.

Mr. McQueen used his retirement to conduct independent research that produced two books, including the previously described *Black Churches in Texas: A Guide to Historic Congregations*. The Prairie View A&M University Special Collections and Archives Department houses the manuscripts and master copies of *Black Churches in Texas*, while the Cushing Memorial Library & Archives at Texas A&M University holds the related research collection.

Scope and Contents Note: The collection is arranged chronologically in the order items were created. No series was needed since the items are all related to the book "Black Churches in Texas" by Clyde McQueen. Box one contains an early manuscript and two proof copies of the text (the proof copies were divided into four folders due to the extensive number of pages). In box two are maps of the study areas by county, early samples of the photo gallery, informational tables and appendices, and the first three reviews of the original master text. Box three contains drafts of the index and bibliography, typesetting proof of cover, first and second revisions of the master, and headshot of author Clyde McQueen. It also has correspondence between the author, Tammy Henry (Texas A&M University Press), and Frank Bruno (former Prairie View A&M University's Director of Libraries).
