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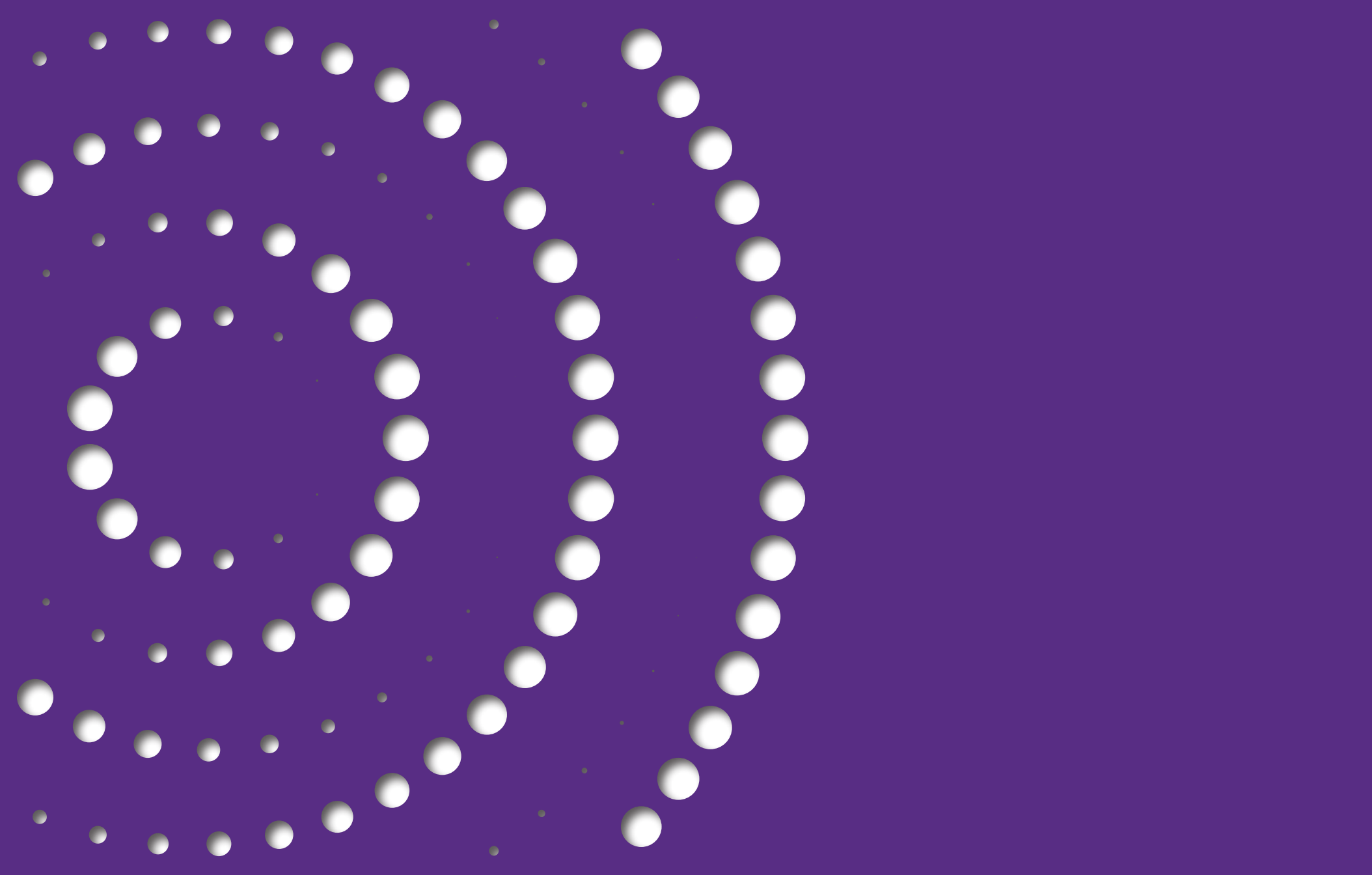

Architecture

Prairie View A&M University's School of Architecture is dedicated to preparing students to play a leadership role in shaping the future, rebuilding America's cities, and improving the quality of the built environment. The School of Architecture will educate significant practitioners and leaders in architecture, planning, and construction by offering a diverse curriculum led by an accomplished faculty in a computer and studio-intensive environment. The School of Architecture is one of eight architecture accredited programs in Texas and one of only seven Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) accredited architecture programs in the United States. The Prairie View A&M University School of Architecture is ranked as the No. 1 Producer of African American Undergraduates and Graduates in Architecture. It is also the most prominent program among the HBCUs, with more graduates annually contributing to the nation's less than 2% licensed African American architects.

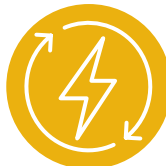
