### NOTES

- 1. LSC students are encouraged to complete the appropriate equivalent to the courses listed above (total of 66 hours) at LSC. Some of these courses are not required by the AA certification at LSC, but are required by the BBA program at PVAMU.
- 2. MATH 1325 (Calculus) at LSC is not required by the BBA program at PVAMU; however, it can be used as a substitute for MATH 1153 (Finite Math) at PVAMU.
- 3. BUSI 2372 (Business Analysis) at LSC can be used as a substitute for MGMT 1163 (Quant. Business Analysis) at PVAMU.
- 4. MATH 1324 (Math for Bus. & Soc. Sc.) and SOCI 1301 (Sociology) taken at LSC cannot be credited toward the BBA program at PVAMU and hence should not be taken at LSC.
- 5. SPCH 1321 (Bus. and Professional Communication) taken at LSC can be counted as an unrestricted elective toward the Management/Marketing degree plan at PVAMU, but not toward other business degree plans.
