Thank you for your interest in the Prairie View A&M University College of Nursing. Nothing is needed from the College of Nursing to register for the TEAS Pre-Assessment Examination. (PV Code is 198687), and the exam can be taken anywhere it is offered.

To complete the Nursing application applicants must maintain a 3.0 GPA Cumulative, and Support Area Sciences (psychology, statistics, nutrition, and human development), and have completed 45 hrs. of the 60 perquisites. If selected for admission, ALL prerequisite courses must be completed by May (fall) or December (spring) terms.

Applicants may submit the following required documents by \*EMAIL to fdsmith@pvamu.edu prior to March 1 for fall and September 1 for spring.

- Verification of acceptance to Prairie View (PV) for fall or spring term.
  - Communications to applicants will be to email provided on the application
- Verify \$60 Nursing Processing Fee (pvamu.edu for Online Services, then Panthers Marketplace and College of Nursing).
- Official transcripts to the PV Office of Admissions. Unofficial transcripts may be submitted to the College of Nursing. To be accepted in Nursing, applicants must be admitted to the University.
- TEAS Scores (Math (74%), English (64%), Reading (75%), and Science (55%) from ATI. Passed within two attempts.
  - Two reference letters (faculty and personal or community service) may be emailed directly to fdsmith@pvamu.edu.

If accepted, the applicant must complete all requirements as listed in the current Prairie View A&M University Catalog at <a href="https://www.pvamu.edu">www.pvamu.edu</a>.
