<b>Posture and Eye Contact</b>	Strong posture and/or stage presence; appears relaxed and confident. Establishes eye contact with everyone in the room.	Good posture and/or stage presence and establishes eye contact with everyone.	Adequate posture used; establish little eye contact with the audience.	Posture and/or stage presence are distracting and little to no eye contact established.	

<b>Pitch and Volume</b>	Pitch conveyed emotions appropriately. Speaker is heard by all audience members throughout the presentation.	Pitch used but the emotion conveyed was not always as expected. Speaker is heard by all audience members most of the time.	Pitch rarely used or emotion conveyed not expected. Speaker is heard by audience members some of the time.	Pitch was not used to convey emotion. Volume often too low to be heard by all audience.
