IACUC Non-Compliance

Instances of non-compliance may include, but are not limited to:

- Housing animals in unapproved facilities
- Beginning research projects without IACUC approval
- Wrongful/abusive physical or psychological treatment of an animal
- Involvement of personnel not listed in an approved protocol
- Personnel conducting research prior to their addition to an approved protocol.

Reporting Consequences:

If an activity is suspended due to non-compliance, the IO shall promptly report that action to the appropriate federal oversight bodies. The IO is required to promptly provide all oversight bodies including the National Science Foundation (NSF), the Department of Defense (DOD), and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) with a full explanation of the actions taken regarding serious or continuing noncompliance, serious deviations from the provisions of the Guide, and/or suspension of an activity by the IACUC.
