

# Navigating Campus

When traveling to campus, it is important to plan your arrival and departure in advance—familiarizing yourself with the main campus ([Check out the campus map](#)). By testing your commute schedule prior to the semester start and arriving at the campus at least 15-20 minutes before the start of class can reduce travel stressors.
