Career Fair and Students' Placement

Since 2010 the students in the Construction Science program at Prairie View A&M University have participated In job fairs both on and off campus. The on-campus events were traditionally organized and run by the Career Services Department of PVAMU and held in a central location. While the events offered a diverse collection of firms, often the attendance by firms in the construction industry was very small.

Off campus events were organized by the College of Architecture at Texas A&M University, by the Houston Chapter of the National Organization of Minority Architects (NOMAS), and by the Houston Chapter of the Construction Specifications Institute (CSI). Often the distance to the location and/or the timing of the event, prevented a strong turnout by our students.

During the Spring Semester 2018, the Construction Science program underwent an outside review as prescribed by the Office of the Provost. Representatives of Auburn University and Florida A&M University recommended as part of their finding that the program commence holding its own career fairs in their facility. With assistance from the Director of the Texas A&M University Construction Career Fairs, this change in direction took place in the Fall Semester 2018. Since that semester a SOA Career Fair has been held every Fall and Spring Semester of the academic year.

The Fall Semester career fair typically focused on the Construction Science program, while the Spring Semester career fair focused on the Architecture program. In 2019 several construction firms asked to return to the Spring Semester event noting that since the SOA has students earning a double degree in Architecture and Construction Science, they wanted to participate in both session. Following that breakthrough in 2020 the event was renamed as "ARCH + CONS Career Fair Spring 2020." All career fairs since 2020 have allowed both design and construction firms to participate. A chart detailing the growth of the events is provided below.

The chapter received a prestigious award in January 2023, being named the ABC Student Chapter of the Year for 2022.




