Test IN PERSON at a NON-PVAMU Test Site

To test at a non-PVAMU test location, testers must obtain a TSI Remote Voucher from the Office of Testing Services. To receive that voucher, testers will need to follow the steps below:

STEP 1 - LOCATE A TEST SITE

Tester(s) can search for a test site in their area using the Test Center Locator:

https://studentportal.accuplacer.org/#/studentsitesearch.

* NOTE: If you cannot find a test center using the locator, contact a Testing or Assessment Center at the nearest educational institution (College or University) in your area to see if a test proctor can administer the exam.



Once testers have located a test site, they will go to www.pvamu.edu/tsi and complete the registration process for testing by clicking "Register for TSIA."

- In the TSIA Registration Form,
 - o If you found the site <u>using</u> the test center locator, you must provide the following: Institution's Name, Address, Email, and Phone Number.
 - If you found the site <u>without using</u> the test center locator, you must provide the following: Institution's Name, Address, Email, Phone Number, Name and Title of Test Proctor.

STEP 3 – TEST SITE VERIFICATION

Upon the tester's completion of the TSI Pre-Assessment Activity, the TSI registration form and payment of the exam fee. Testing Services will contact the test site to verify that they are still administering exams for non-students.

* **NOTE**: Testing Services will contact the tester to assist them in finding another remote location if the site cannot be verified.

STEP 4 – RECEIVE TEST VOUCHER

Once a test site has been verified, testers will receive further instructions via email to set up their test date and time with the proctoring location.

* **PROCTORING FEE NOTE**: Test sites will charge a proctoring fee to administer the exam to non-students. This is separate from the exam fee paid to Testing Services, and proctoring fees vary per test site.
