



Accessing Your ACCUPLACER Scores

Student Portal Guide

The ACCUPLACER® Student Portal lets you view your Individual Score Report (ISR), reprint it, and send your scores to other institutions. Visit the portal at: studentportal.accuplacer.org.

Before you begin: You must have entered an email address when you originally took your test. If you didn't, you can't access your scores through the portal. Contact the institution where you tested to obtain your score report directly.

Part 1: View or Reprint Your Score Report

1. Go to studentportal.accuplacer.org. From the left navigation menu, select **Your Score Report**.

2. On the **Search for Your Score Report** screen, enter the same information you provided when you took your test. Then click the **Search** button.

Note: When selecting your institution, choose the one linked to your ACCUPLACER test. This is the school responsible for your testing, such as the test center where you sat for the exam or the institution that issued your test voucher. This may not be the school you currently attend.

If the information you entered doesn't match a record on file, you'll see the message below.

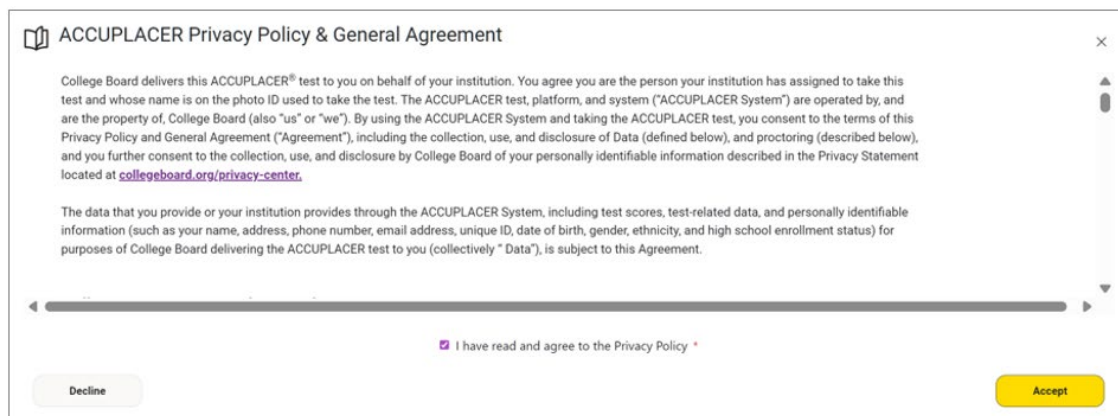

4. A **Privacy Policy & General Agreement** screen will appear. Read the policy, check the **I have read and agree to the Privacy Policy** box, then click **Accept**. You must accept this policy to receive the email.



5. Check your inbox for an email from **NoReply@accuplacer.info** with the subject line **Your ACCUPLACER Test Results**. If you don't see it, check your spam or junk folder. Click the **View ISR** button in the email.

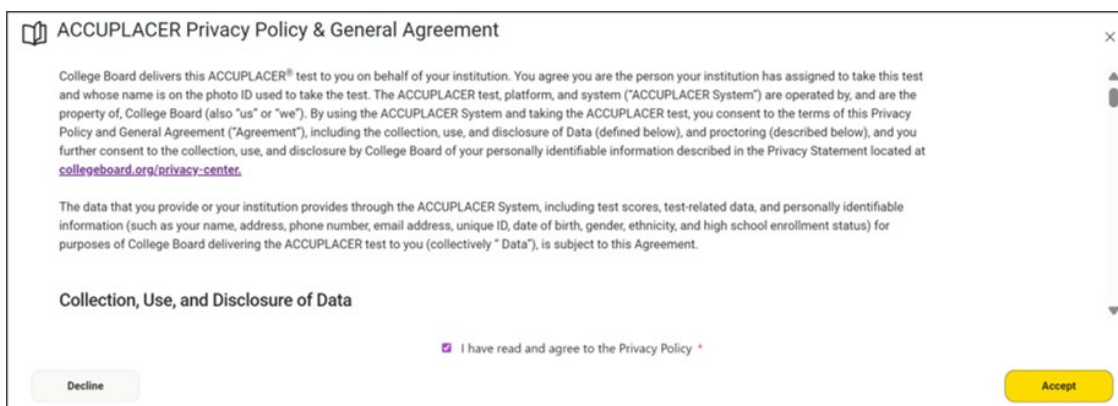

6. A second **Privacy Policy & General Agreement** screen will appear. Check the box and click **Accept** again to proceed.

Note: The Privacy Policy appears twice: once when triggering the email, and once when opening the ISR link. Both must be accepted.



7. Your score report will load, showing all test sessions with their dates and scores. If you have tested more than once, each session appears as a separate entry. Click **View Complete Report** to view or print your ISR.
