

Mini Grand Rounds



Alumni Spotlight: Dr. Sanique South, PhD


Dr. Sanique South graduated from Prairie View A&M University and Texas Undergraduate Medical Academy in 2011 with a double major in Biology and Nutrition, and a minor in Chemistry. Dr. South went on to Texas Woman's University where she earned a master's in health education in 2013 and a PhD in Nutrition in 2020. Her doctoral training focused on understanding the anti-inflammatory properties of whole blueberries in osteoarthritis. Her research and training led to numerous travel awards, grants, and scholarships, including being nominated as a finalist in the American Society for Nutrition's (ASN) Emerging Leaders in Nutrition Science Competition at ASN's Scientific Sessions Annual Meeting in 2016.

After completing her PhD, Dr. South began postdoctoral research with Dr. Tim Griffin at the Oklahoma Medical Research Foundation. Her research was aimed at establishing a novel approach for using Imaging Mass Cytometry to analyze the mouse synovial joint and




optimizing the knee environment for intra-articular osteoarthritis therapies. In 2022, she received the New Investigator Recognition Award from the Orthopaedic Research Society for her work with Dr. Griffin.

Since 2022, Dr. South has been expanding her translational experience, and postdoctoral training with Dr. Nick Willett at the Phil and Penny Knight Campus for Accelerating Impact at the University of Oregon. Her research involves the development of new regenerative medicine approaches to treat osteoarthritis and to establish a predictive model to identify therapeutic potential of human mesenchymal stromal cell donors for optimized clinical translation of cell therapy treatment for osteoarthritis.













Q&A with Dr. South

Q. How did you decide on your chosen career path? Did you consider others prior?

Initially, I was interested in pursuing a MD/PhD, but while engaging in research during my undergraduate studies, my passion for research grew and I decided to pursue a research career. I have a passion for research, and I am committed to impacting the world positively through my discoveries.

Q: What was the best or most helpful thing about being part of the UMA?

The community and support the UMA provided was very beneficial throughout my academic journey. The UMA provided opportunities for professional development through networking and summer internship programs. My first internship program with Dr. Brett Mitchell at Texas A&M University was amazing and I had to opportunity to return the following year to continue my project with his lab. This resulted in two co-authored manuscripts with his lab and lifelong mentorship. In addition, as an international student with out-of-state tuition, the financial support through scholarships helped me to complete my studies at PVAMU and pursue my research career.

Q: What's one piece of advice you can give to current students in the process of applying to professional schools?

During your undergraduate program, there are not many opportunities to gain significant employment or research experience. I suggest taking advantage of the available summer internship programs, which will help in your professional development and enhance your application to professional schools. When attending conferences be purposeful about networking. Before applying, research the programs, and gather information from a variety of programs then narrow your choices. Focus on programs that align with your personal and professional goals. In addition, never limit yourself: apply broadly and be flexible.
