FRAMING

A frame of reference, or point of view, refers to the way we look at a given situation. How a person views that situation can affect their understanding of the facts and influence how they determine right from wrong.

MAJOR POLICY CHANGE

PVAMU SMOKING POLICY



Major changes to Policy 34.05.99.P1 Smoking were made November 2019. These changes include the following:

- Smoking is ONLY permitted in parking lots at a distance of at least 100 feet from any entrance door or window.

- Additionally, as of 11/22/2019 the use of e-cigarettes and vaping is no longer allowed on campus.
