AAM Special Issue Policy

Although, publishing a Special Issue is a very time consuming and laborious, request for a Special Issue for Conferences is welcomed.

Publication of manuscripts in a Special Issue is subject to AAM's Guide for Authors, as a regular manuscript publication. Final decision for acceptance or rejection of a manuscript will be up to the Editor-in-Chief of AAM.

A proposal for a Special Issue should address the following minimum items:

1. Estimated number of manuscripts and pages in the Special Issue. There should be at least 5 accepted manuscripts for a Special Issue to be posted.
2. Possible potential Guest Editors (names and vitae) and possible Guest Editors' Liaison to communicate with me. There should be at least 3 Guest Editor for a Special Issue.
3. Specific responsibilities of each Guest Editor should be stated.
4. Each manuscript should be reviewed by at least two qualified reviewers, who are experts in the field. Manuscripts must also be edited by an editor for English language.
5. Authors may have a chance to revise their reviewed manuscripts only one time. If the first revision is not satisfactory, it will not be accepted for publication.
6. It is the author's responsibility to send the final version of an accepted manuscript formatted and makes it published ready according to AAM Author's Guidelines by its

deadline. The Guest Liaison is responsible to check and make sure that is the case. However, the Editor-in-Chief reserve the right to contact an author for revising and addressing corrections needed. A manuscript that is not ready by the publication deadline will not be published.

7. A proposal should include a timeline that does not conflict with publication of the regular issues (June and December of each year).
