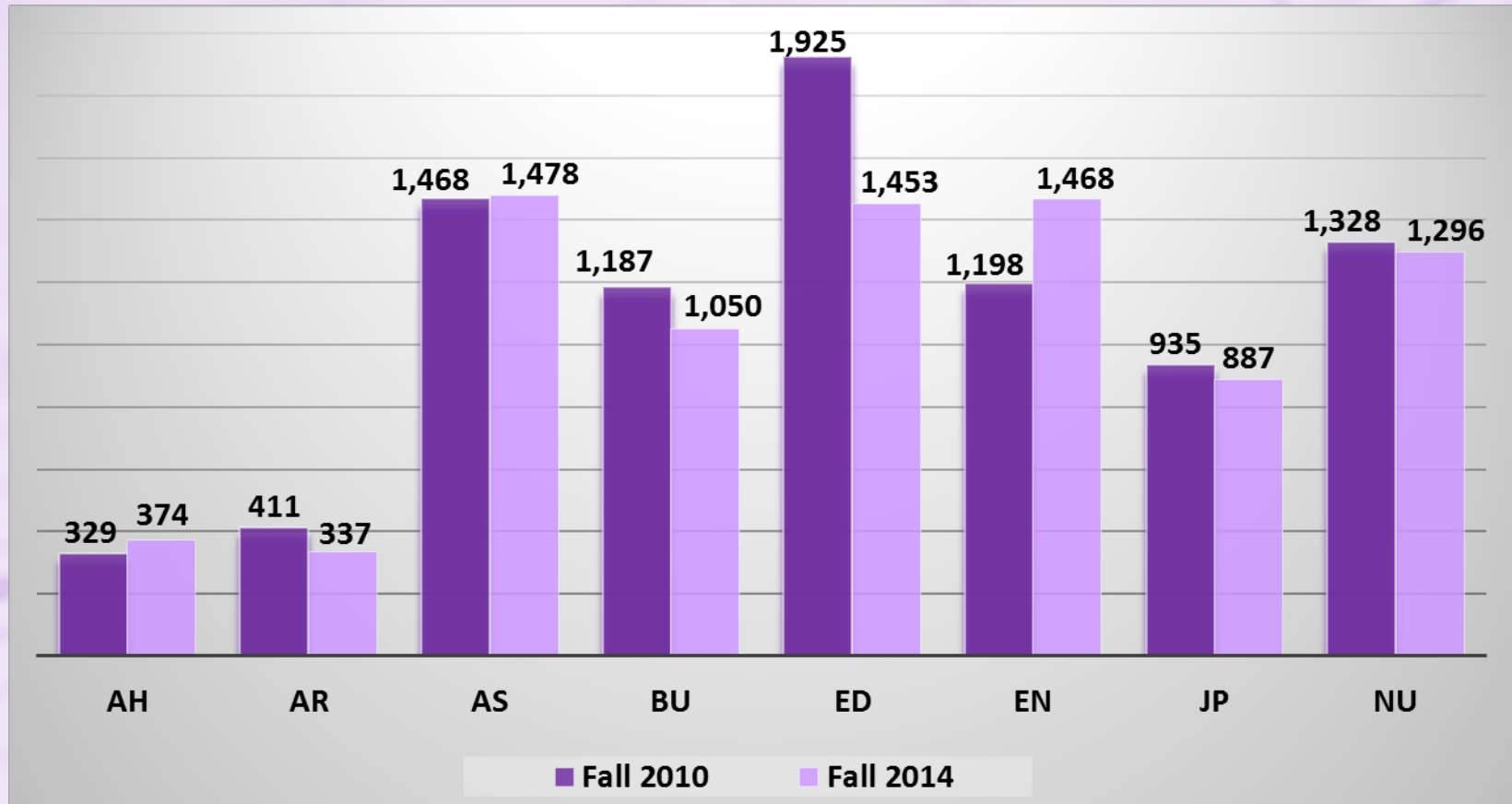

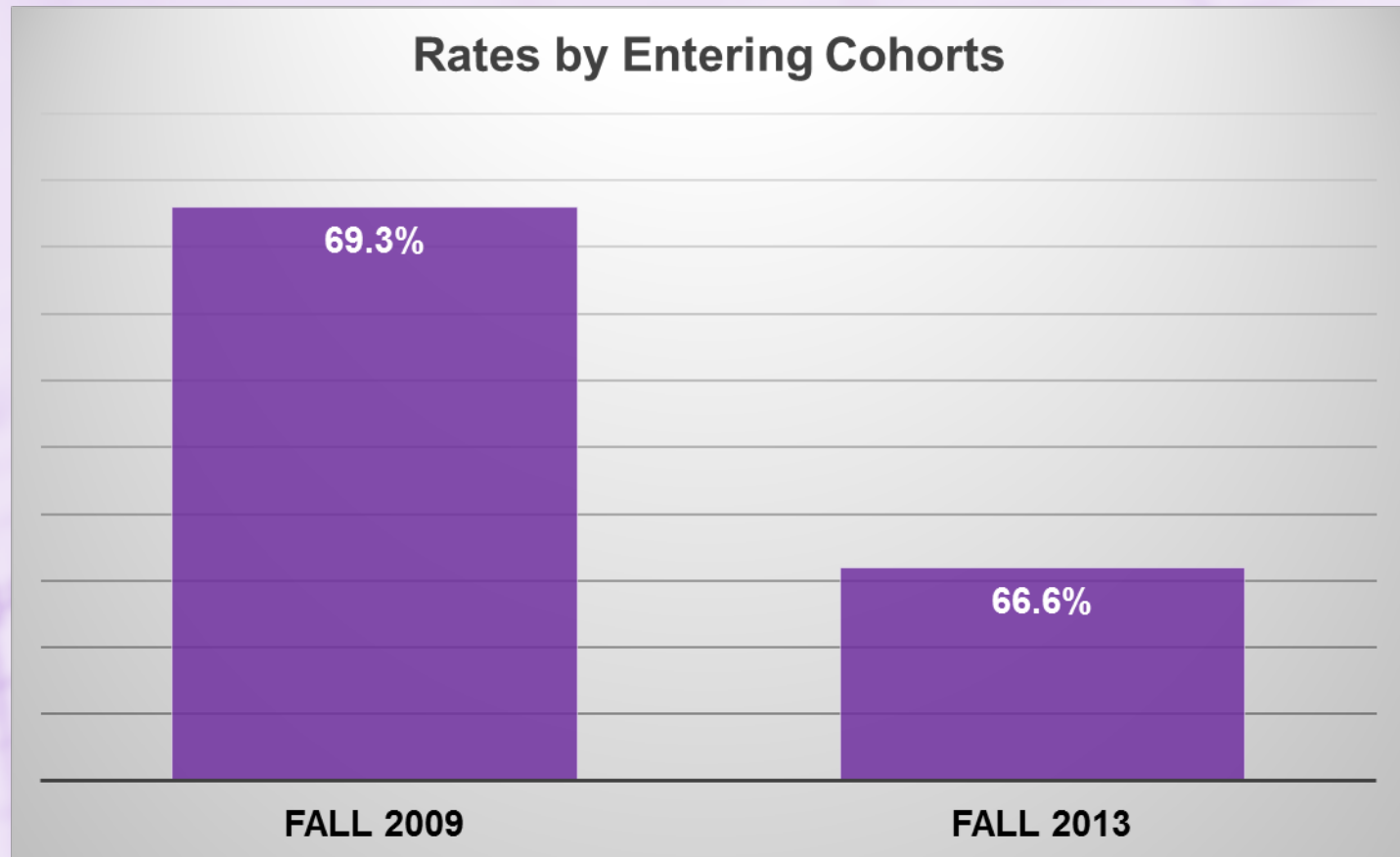

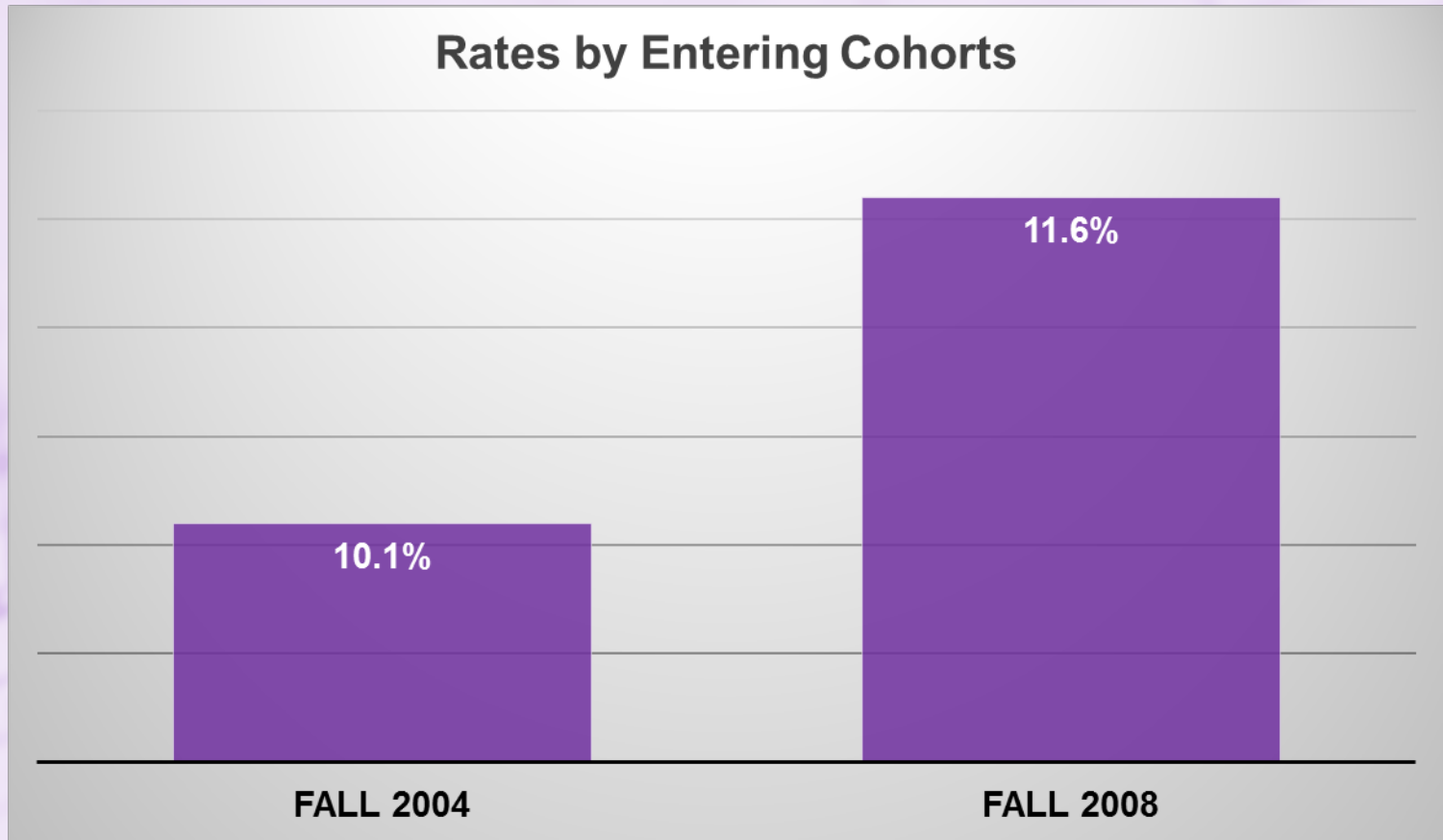

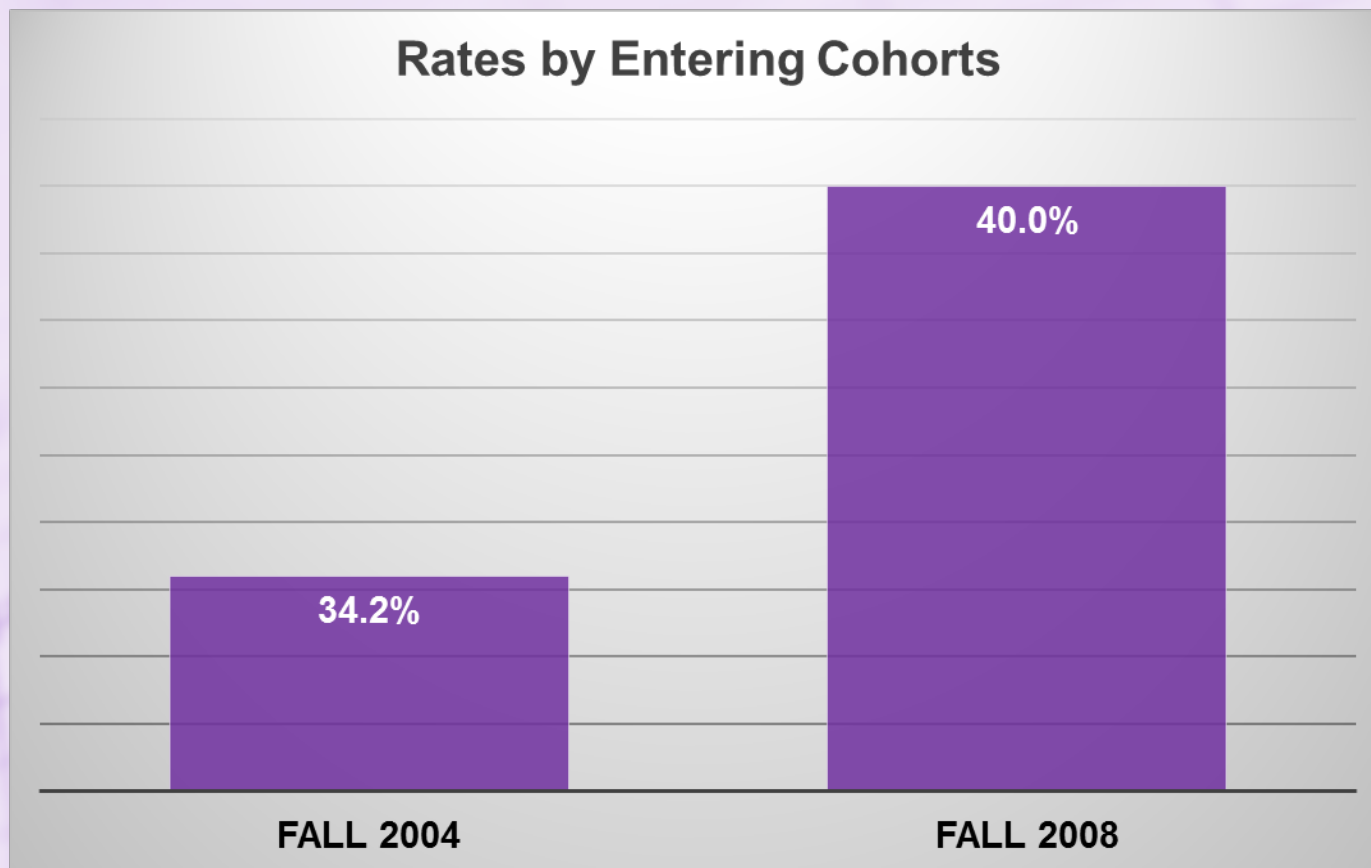
One-Year Persistence Rates

6-Year Graduation Rates

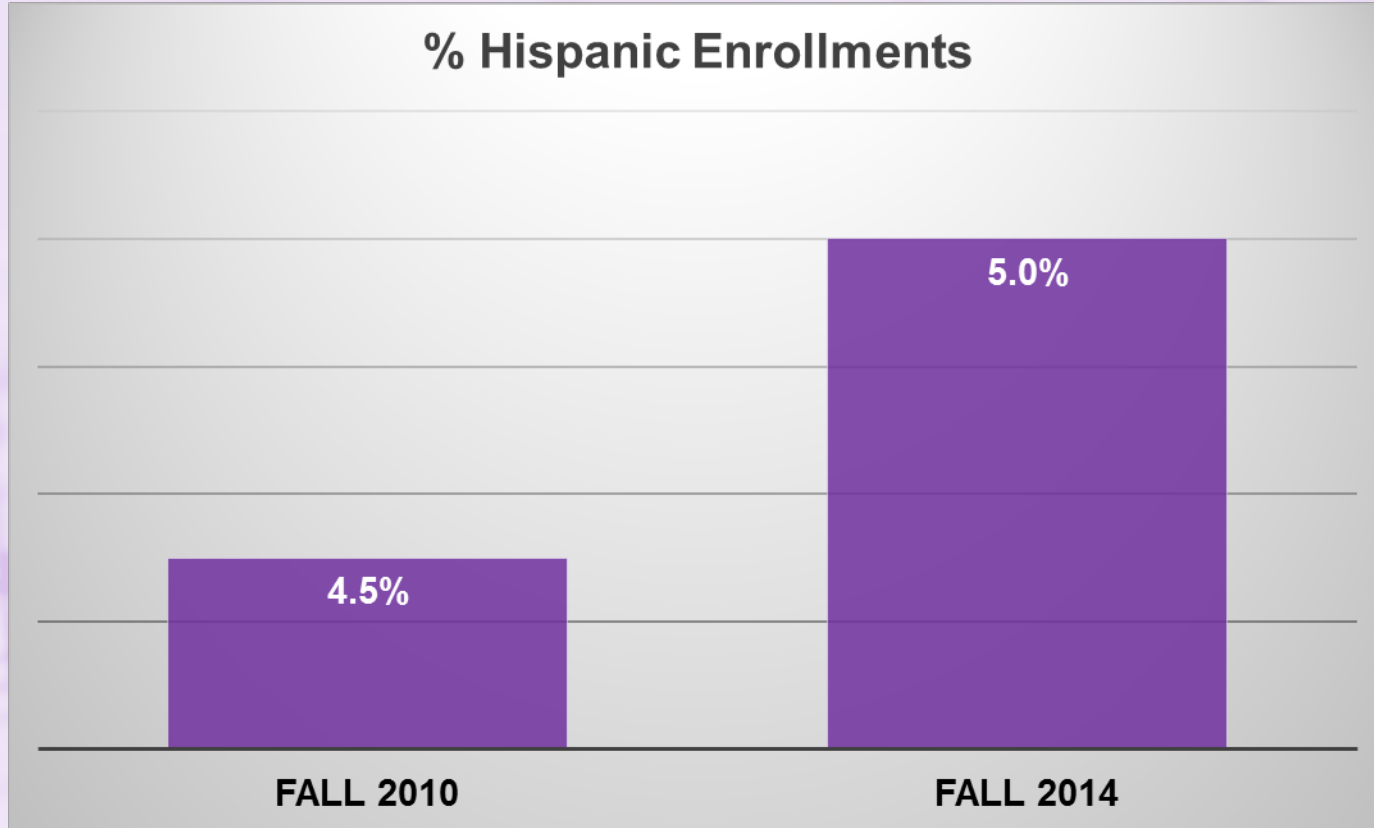

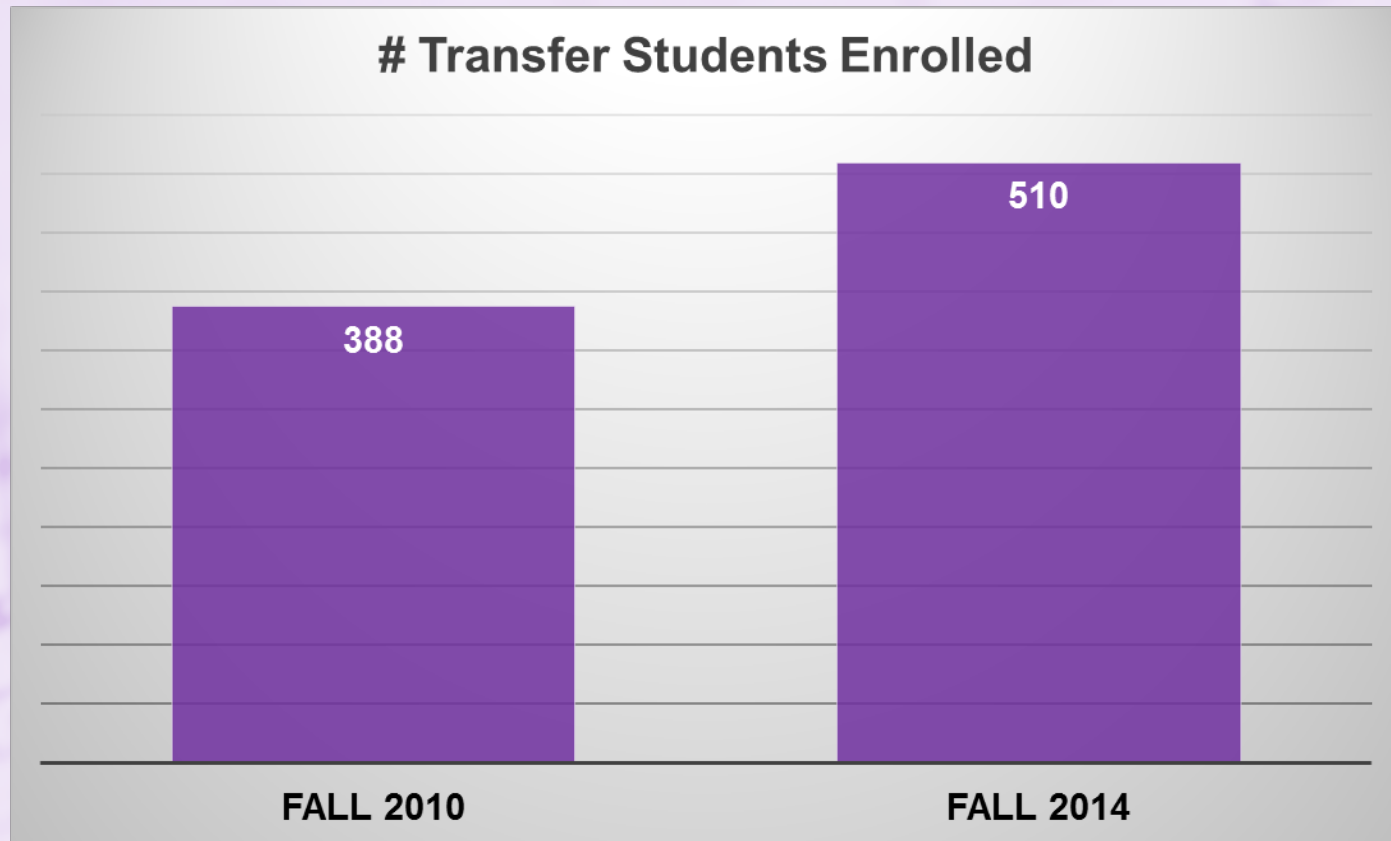

Transfer Enrollments

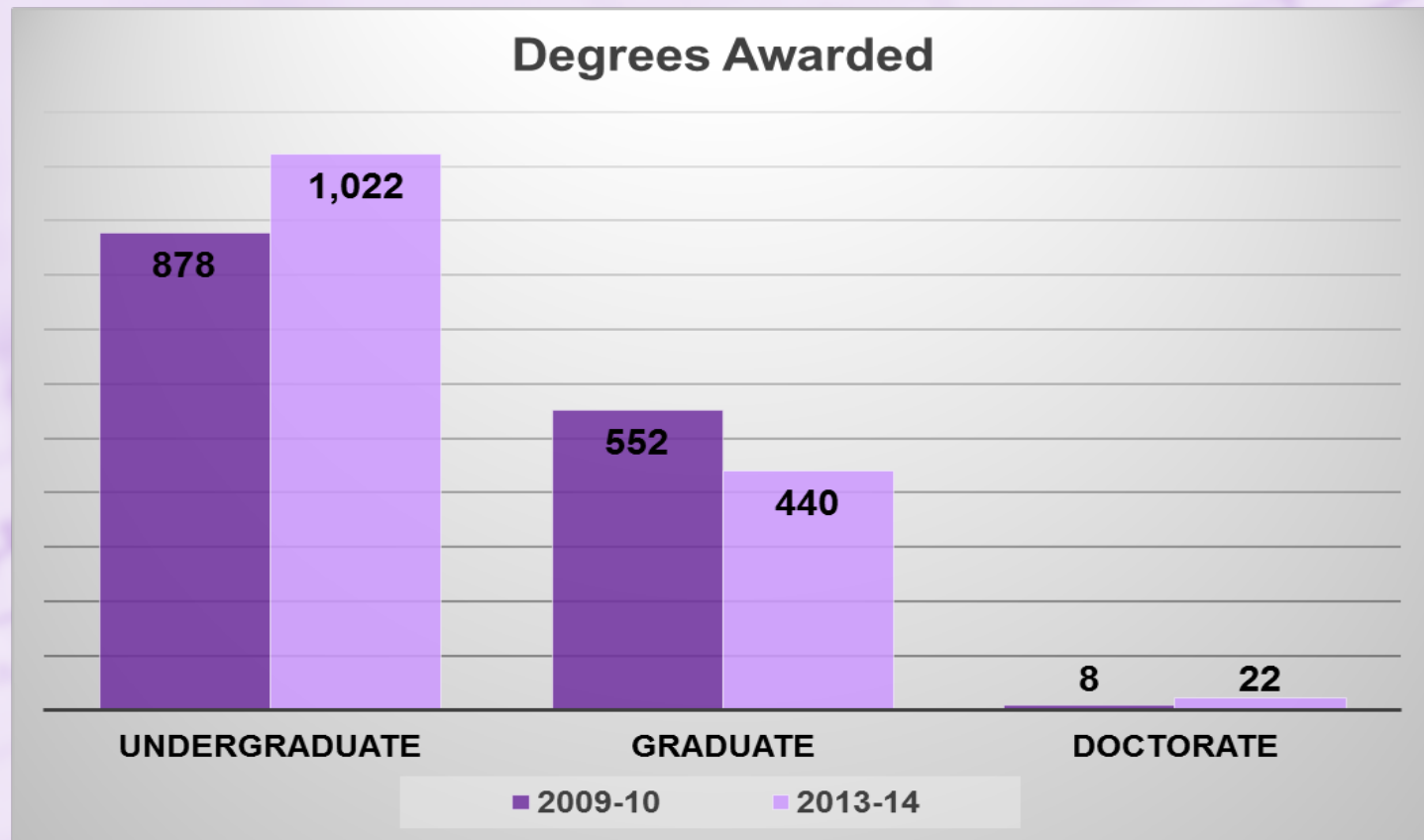

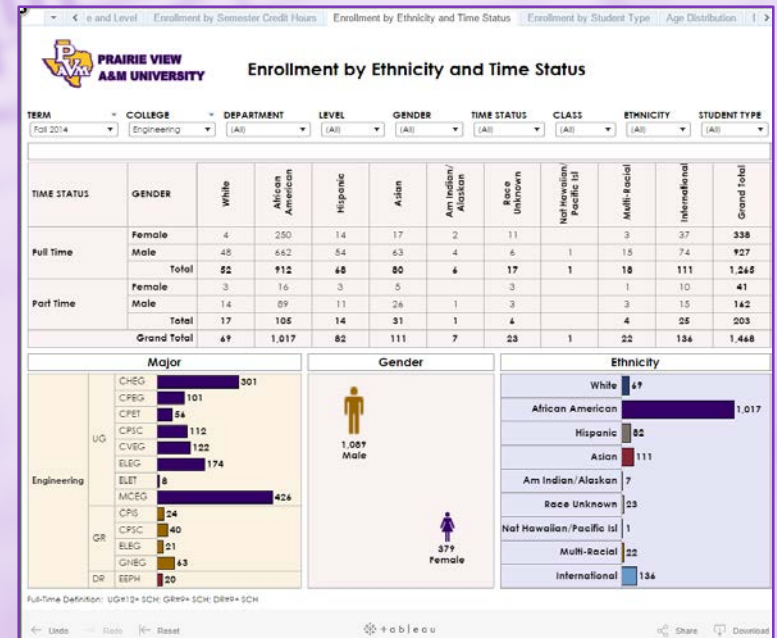

Enrollment by Term and Classification

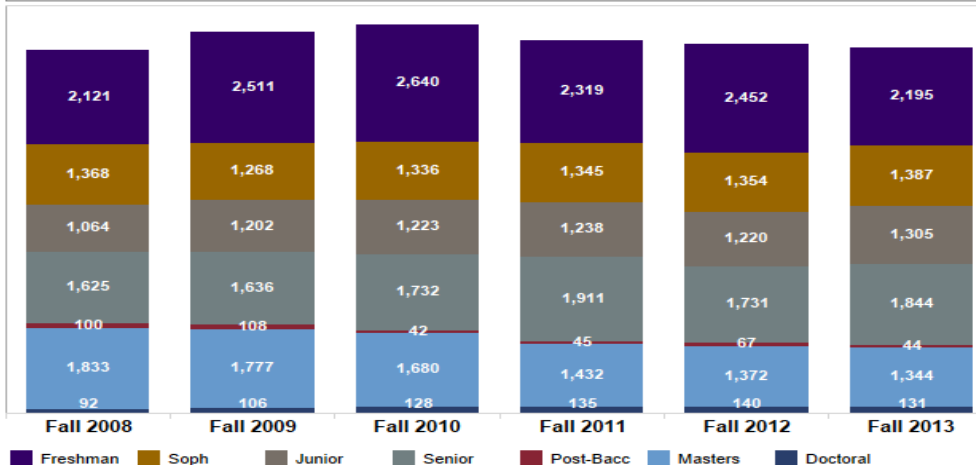

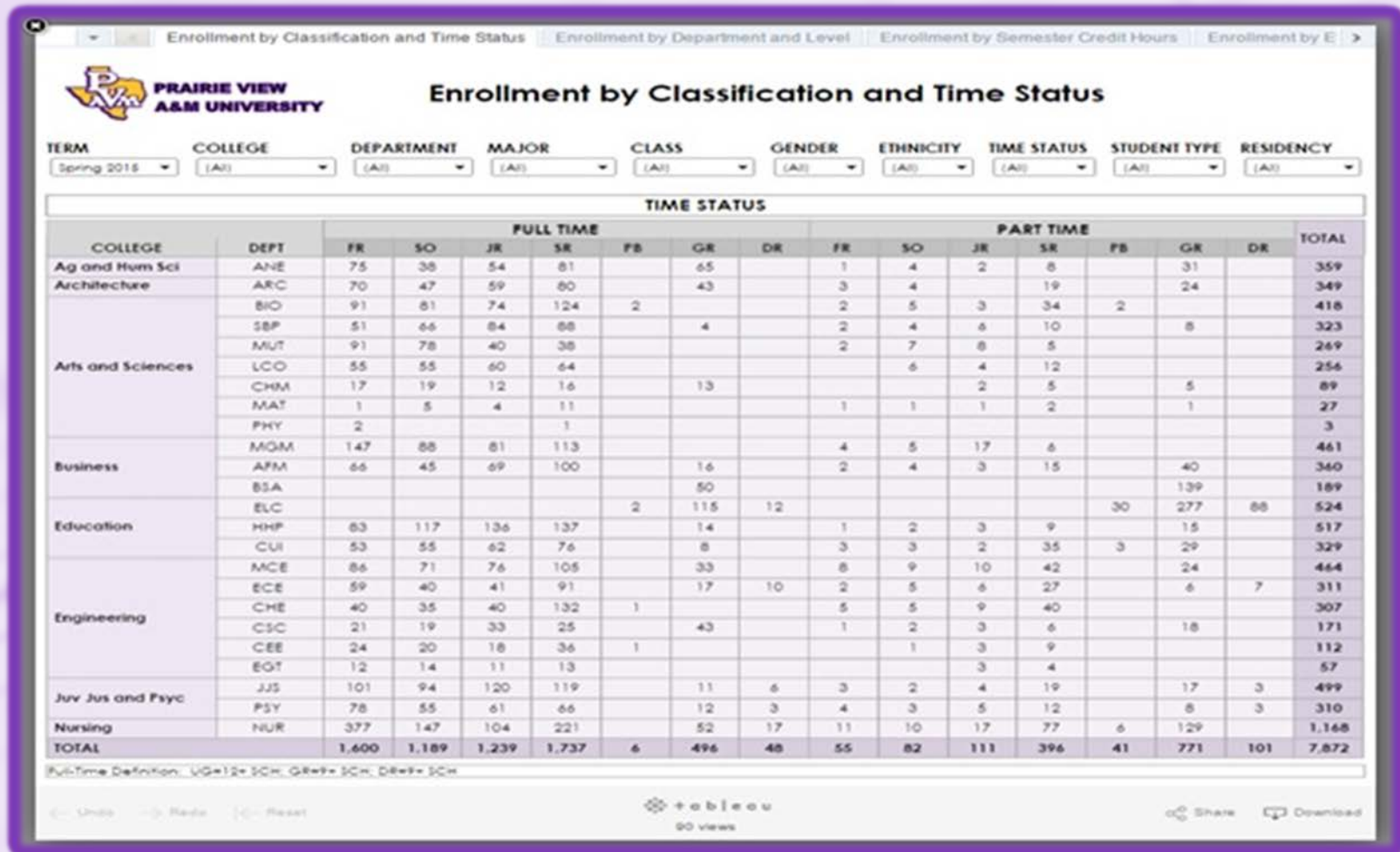

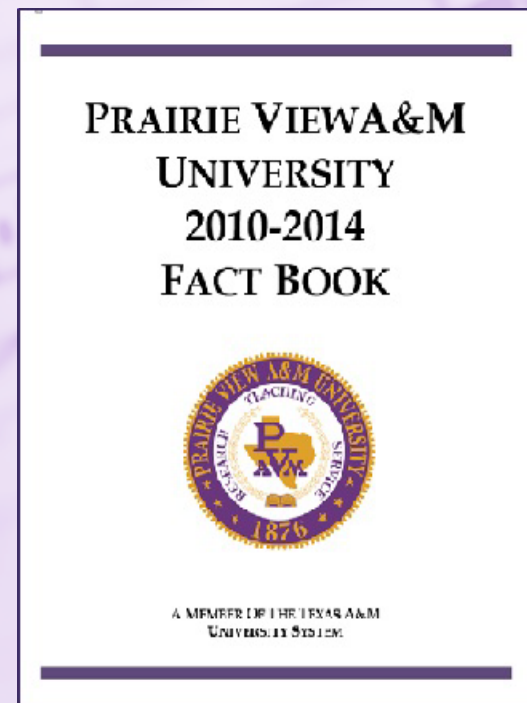
