PRAIRIE VIEW, **Texas** (May 2, 2024) – As the spring semester at Prairie View A&M University draws to a close, we are pleased to announce the upcoming 142nd Spring Commencement Convocation. This year, the ceremony will be held on May 10-11, to accommodate the 918 undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral students who successfully completed their academic programs.

After completing years of hard work, 772 undergraduate, 133 master's, and 13 doctoral students will walk across the stage. Nearly one-third of the semester's undergraduate candidates are first-generation college graduates—a testament to the University's tagline, "Pioneers emerge here."

The University's total alumni count will stand at over 83,552 "Proud and Productive Panthers" following the event.
