



PVAMU'S 30TH FALL COMMENCEMENT SHOWCASES FIRST-GEN GRADS, FILM INNOVATORS, AND A PHD AT AGE 60

PRAIRIE VIEW, Texas (December 8, 2025)- Prairie View A&M University will host its 30th Fall Commencement on Friday, December 12, at 6 p.m. and Saturday, December 13, at 9 a.m. in the William "Billy" J. Nicks, Sr. Building (Baby Dome).

Friday evening will honor Master's and Doctoral candidates. Saturday will include all Undergraduate candidates.

The fall graduating class represents more than 689 degree candidates, including:

- Doctorate: 14
- Master's: 159
- Undergraduate: 516

In a powerful milestone, 27% of undergraduate candidates (139 students) are first-generation college graduates. This year's ceremonies mark continued progress toward a legacy of producing more than **86,000 productive Panthers** who lead in fields across the nation.

Notable Graduates (media interview recommended):

- **Sylvia Sydney Bridges (BA, Communications)**: First in her family to graduate.
- **Patt Williams (PhD)**: Began doctoral studies at age 60.
- **Terri Taylor (Doctor of Nursing Practice)**: First in her family to earn a doctorate; focused on equitable maternal health.
- **Micah Beard (BA Communication)**: Emerging filmmaker defining a new era of Black storytelling in film. Media are invited to spotlight student success leading up to Commencement.
