Global Economist Munir Quddus, Ph.D.: "Crisis is destined to leave its mark on America and the world."

**PRAIRIE VIEW**, Texas – The stock market has unceremoniously crashed, losing nearly a third of its value over a short span of a few trading days. It has been a bloodbath for investors, with equities in all sectors of the economy in steep decline. Those who follow stocks closely will agree that very few sectors were spared in the March Madness on Wall Street.

Prairie View A&M University College of Business Dean Munir Quddus, Ph.D., began focusing his attention on the global economic market when the coronavirus spread began as a ripple in Asia. When the virus began its spread beyond China like tidal waves, Dr. Quddus began to track the financial fallout of the coronavirus pandemic.

"The widespread losses cannot be easily or quickly recouped. Unless the government is able to work with Congress to roll out a package of comprehensive relief, we may be looking at a long economic winter," said Quddus who earned his Doctorate of Economics at Vanderbilt University.
