Coach Tremaine Jackson purchased tickets for federal employees who want to attend the home game against Alabama State.

PRAIRIE VIEW, Texas (October 31, 2025)- <u>Prairie View A&M University</u> Head Football Coach Tremaine Jackson purchased 100 tickets for the <u>football</u> game on Saturday, November 1, so federal employees affected by the government shutdown can attend at no cost.

Federal employees can claim one free ticket each (with a valid federal ID) at the stadium's will-call window.
