More than 5,500 students will be recognized for their academic achievement in 2023. Students on the Dean's Honors list earned a 3.0-3.49 GPA, while those who earned a 3.5-4.0 GPA are named to the University Honor Roll list.

McFrazier, Interim Provost and Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs, says the occasion is also an opportunity to reflect with reverence on the memory of the first eight students enrolled at the University.
