



## PVAMU STUDENTS TAKE CENTER STAGE IN “STATE OF THE HILL,” A POWERFUL DISPLAY OF DEMOCRACY, LEADERSHIP, AND LEGACY

PRAIRIE VIEW, Texas (January 23, 2026)- Democracy is not a theory at [Prairie View A&M University](#). It is practiced, debated, challenged, and carried forward by students who understand the power of their voice. That spirit will be on full display when the forty-fourth administration of Prairie View A&M University [Student Government Association](#) (SGA) hosts its annual State of the Hill, a campus-wide forum centered on student advocacy, shared governance, and the future of the Hill.

The event will feature [SGA](#) President Jaquavous Doucette, who also serves as [Student Regent](#) for the Texas A&M University System, alongside SGA Executive Vice President Eddie Fowler III, class presidents from freshman through senior classes, the SGA Chief Justice, and members of the executive cabinet. The State of the Hill will take place in the Willie A. Tempton Student Center (MSC) Auditorium on Wednesday, January 28, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m., with a reception and light refreshments immediately following the program.

Together, these students represent a generation of leaders actively shaping policy, elevating student concerns, and ensuring that Prairie View A&M University students are not just heard, they are influential.

“State of the Hill is democracy in action,” said Doucette. “It is about accountability, transparency, and making sure student voices are part of every conversation that shapes our campus today and for generations to come.”

This year’s theme, “Your Voice. Your Hill. Your Legacy.”, reflects SGA’s commitment to honoring Prairie View A&M’s rich history while empowering students to leave their mark on the institution’s future.
