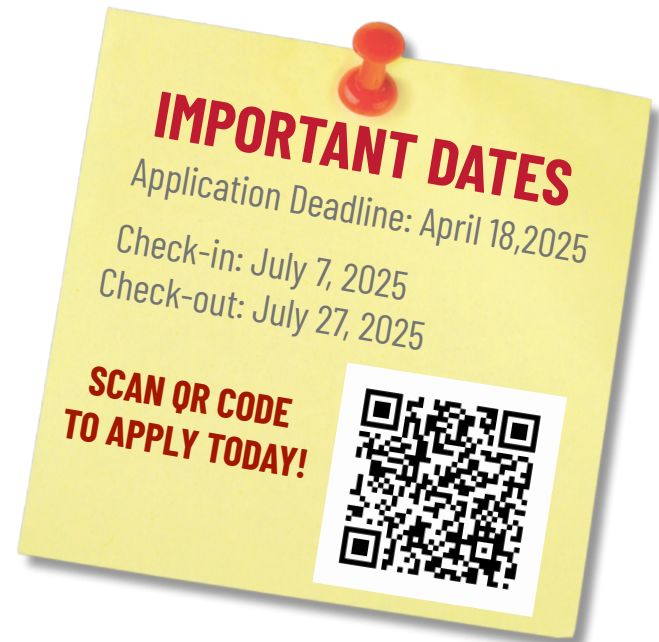
COLLEGE OF FOOD, AGRICULTURAL, AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES MEAT SCIENCE EXTENSION

Under the tutelage of Dr. Garcia, Associate Professor, students will accompany her at carcass show hosted by county fair where they will learn carcass evaluation and translate impacts of livestock management practices on overall carcass merit, such as meat quality and percent saleable product using USDA formulas estimating yields for beef, pork, and lamb/goat.

Students will also assist with youth and adult extension-education carcass evaluation programs developing leadership and twenty-first century skills. **Flight, housing, and three meals daily included.**
