Re: Third Confirmed Case of COVID-19

Today, we were informed that a third individual from the Prairie View A&M University community has tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19).

The individual is an undergraduate student in the Marvin D. And June Samuel Brailsford College of Arts and Sciences who was last on campus March 6. In accordance with PVAMU policy and guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the student is self-isolating off campus. Because the student has not had any face-to-face contact with students, faculty or staff since March 6, we have determined that members of the campus community are not at an increased risk.

This crisis is causing untold danger and anxiety throughout the world. Let us pray for a speedy recovery for COVID-19 victims, continued health for members of our community, and a resumption of normalcy in the coming weeks.

Now, more than ever, it is imperative that we do all that we can to slow the spread of this virus.
