Young Global Pioneers connects young talents from all around the world. We believe that both leadership and talent come in many different shapes and sizes. To YGP, leadership and talent are also about striving to make a difference, and having the ambition to make it happen.

In Tanzania all activities, meals, domestic flights, accommodation and local guides are included in the scholarship. Additionally, the scholarship recipient will receive 3.000 USD to partly cover costs such as international flight tickets, insurances, vaccinations, visa and pocket money.

To be eligible for the Accenture Scholarship you must meet the following criteria:

- Be 18-22 years old
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.2
- Be currently pursuing a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with a graduation date of no later than December 2019, All majors considered

The deadline for applying is April 5th 2016. Applicants will hear back from YGP no later than April 12th and the final selection will be at the end of April 2016.
