Re: Stay Home-Work Safe Orders

Yesterday, Harris County officials joined several counties across the state in issuing "Stay Home-Work Safe" orders. This means that our non-essential university employees are now required to stay home.

For students choosing to remain on campus, this reduction in staff will lead to a dramatic reduction in services with most services moving to the virtual realm. To be clear, we will not be operating our business as usual. Because of this, you may prefer to return home. With the move to online delivery of classes, there is no reason for you to remain on campus.
